HOW TO COMPLY WITH REACH SVHC-IN-ARTICLE REQUIREMENTS

The majority of REACH guidance documents and trainings sessions have focused on the registration requirements and on SIEF activities. Companies who produce primarily articles have not had significant opportunities to receive guidance on complying with their obligations which are most notably: Communication, Notification, Authorization and Restrictions.

In June 2009 we now have a Candidate (SVHC) List of 15 substances and the emerging expectation that this list will grow significantly in very short order. We also are now seeing the first waves of enforcement information released by the member states and indeed violation of

Article 33 will entail fines and penalties (including prison terms, for at least one member state) for noncompliant companies.

Because guidance and training for companies who produce articles has been very limited you may want to consider taking advantage of one of these sessions to get a focused, customized look at the requirements which are directly applicable to your company.

One of the major questions for companies has been how to collect, manage and report SVHC information. We will provide a live demonstration of a software tool that will help manage SVHCs.
